PHARMACIST COMMENTS:

Oxazepam may be a parent drug or metabolite of diazepam, chlordiazepoxide, clorazepate, or temazepam.

Norfentanyl is a fentanyl metabolite.

Noroxycodone is an oxycodone metabolite.

Oxymorphone may be a parent drug or oxycodone metabolite. The half-life of oxymorphone is longer than the half-life of oxycodone; thus it is possible to observe a detectable oxymorphone concentration without detectable oxycodone concentration in patients who take oxycodone.
